

Camp Rules

Whananaki Holiday Park is a family campground, the camp managers have the right to refuse access, and to ask anyone to leave, that they believe will not contribute to the family atmosphere.

- 1. Disorderly behavior, excessive alcohol consumption, or intoxication to the extent that other campers are adversely affected will not be tolerated.
- Animals are welcome by negotiation at certain times of the year. We reserve the
 right to decline any dog without providing reason. Pets are not permitted in any of
 our accommodations, buildings, the communal BBQ area or the swimming pool
 area at any time.
- 3. The facilities here are solely for the use of our guests. There is a \$7 day visitor charge for any person visiting guests in the camp, All guest must register at the office on arrival and be left by 9pm. Any visitors/friends not staying in the camp are to park in the parking areas or outside the park.
- 4. Disruptive noise will not be tolerated, including white noise machines. Especially after 10 p.m. New Year's Eve campers may celebrate within reason.
- 5. Only one motor vehicle is permitted per camp site. All other vehicles may park in the parking areas.
- 6. No chainsaws, generators, compressors, amplifiers or stereo systems allowed. This includes the running of any vehicle engines to charge batteries.
- 7. Speed limit within campground is strictly walking pace.
- 8. All rubbish & Recycling to be contained and stored sensibly on camp sites until placed in the rubbish recycling area.
- 9. For fire safety purposes it is compulsory to leave a 3 meter gap between camp sites. You can place your own tents closer but a clear 1.5 meter gap must exist between your tent/caravan/motorhome and the edge of your site.
- 10. No open fire or fireworks are permitted in the Park grounds or reserve.
- 11. Parental control of children is expected at all times. In consideration for other guests, children are not to be roaming the Park grounds unsupervised between the hours of 9.30pm and 7.00am. The Park playground & Pool are out of bounds from dark until 7.00am.
- 12. No illicit or illegal substances or drugs are to be in the possession of or used by any person within the Park grounds.
