



### Pet Policy

By paying our pet fee (\$10 per pet up to 5 nights) you are agreeing to our pet policies below:

- Companion animals are welcome on our caravan and camping sites (excluding peak season December 20th to after Waitangi Weekend)
- Dogs acceptance is at the managers discretion. Dogs that are aggressive by nature, history, or perception are restricted. Whananaki Holiday Park reserves the right to decline any dog without providing reason. Please contact the park to discuss your pet before arrival.
- Dogs must be supervised at all times and never left unattended, including inside a tent, van, or other accommodation.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times while not in a van or tent or other accommodation: there are no exceptions. No dog 'runs' are to be operated by dog owners.
- For health and safety reasons, pets are not allowed in any common areas of the park, including camp kitchen, ablutions, playground, BBQ area and pool area.
- Pets are not allowed in any of our Cabins or Motel Units.
- Owners are 100% responsible for picking up and disposing of their pets waste in a sealed bag and disposed of in rubbish bins.
- For health and safety reasons, pets must not be washed or cleaned anywhere within the park.
- Dog owners are personally responsible, and will be held to be so, for any and all personal injuries and/or property damage or losses in relation to any actions caused by or because of their dog.
- Management reserves the right to evict any guests whose pet is deemed noisy, disruptive, and aggressive or the subject of a complaint/s from other guests. It is the pet owner's sole responsibility to control and manage their pet. If in the view of park management this has not happened to an acceptable level, the owner and the animal may be evicted from the park immediately.
